





### Construction Impacts:



As construction ramps up on the Rapid Summerhill project, we want to make sure everyone stays informed about the latest updates, including potential impacts to traffic. Beginning in the coming weeks, construction activity will cause periodic lane reductions along key streets in downtown Atlanta. Specifically, there will be times when travel lanes along MLK Jr. Drive will be reduced to just one lane, and Mitchell Street SW will see travel lanes reduced to two lanes. We encourage you to plan accordingly, as these lane closures may cause some delays. 


#### On-Street Parking Impacts:

On street parking between Crumley Street and Glenn Street will be closed during the next phase of construction as the team continues to prepare for future BRT station installations and road widening. All drivers along the route should adhere to posted signage such as the 'No Street Parking' sign below. Any vehicles that obscure construction activity will be towed at the owners expense. Parking in this area will be accessible for patrons at the deck attached to Publix.
